**E1** *Editor's Note: Oracle continues to improve and modernize the User Interface with the release of the EnterpriseOne 9.1.5 UI. The 9.1 Tools Update 5 switches users to a responsive layout and provides some new productivity tools. ### Introduction

The EnterpriseOne 9.1.5 User Interface introduces a responsive, modern design and adds some great new productivity tools. Features include enhanced navigation tools like Breadcrumb History, Embedded E1 Pages and Simplified Navigation; an easier way to communicate through the Collaborate tools and great new Clear Forms features for starting new Find/Browse queries. This article reviews all of the new 9.1.5 features in detail.

## Modern Alta User Interface Design

Oracle has adopted a new User Interface called Alta that provides a cross-device, uncluttered, clear and consistent layout and user experience.

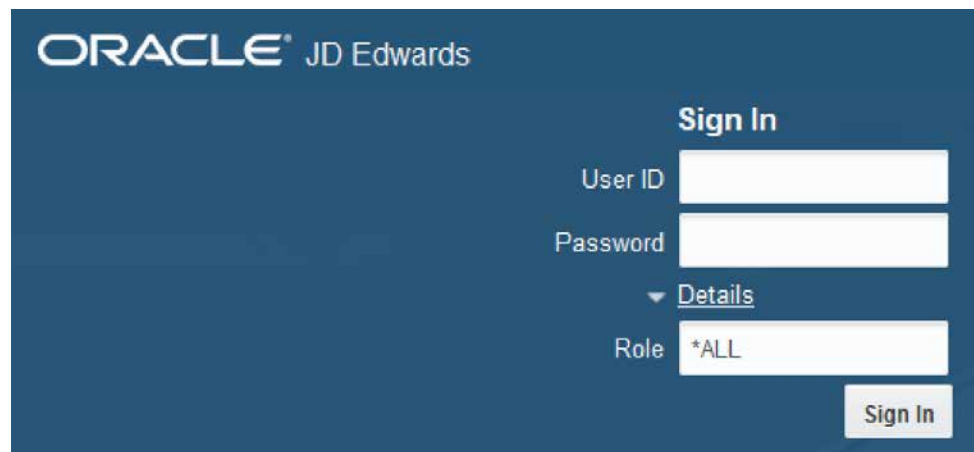


Figure 1: Logon Screen

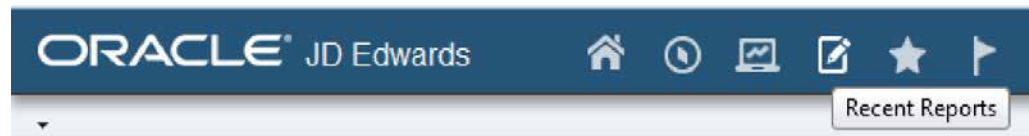


Figure 2: The Menu Bar Switched to Icons

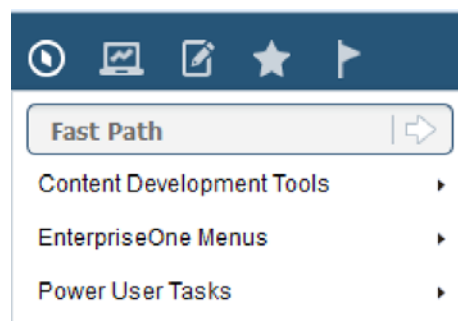


Figure 3: New Location for Fast Path in Navigation Dropdown
