



## EnterpriseOne 9.1 User Interface

**Editor's Note:** The new EnterpriseOne 9.1 User Interface ("UI" to those in the know) gives E1 a more modern look and feel, and includes many helpful features. ### Introduction

When your end users first look at the EnterpriseOne 9.1 User Interface, they'll notice right away that it looks very different from previous releases of E1 and may be a little lost using the new features. However, a little knowledge goes a long way, and I'll be showing you screenshots of every enhancement to the UI. Use this knowledge, plus a few tips at the end of this article, to smooth out the process of preparing your end users for the 9.1 UI.

I'll be giving an overview of the new look and feel, including:

This document covers new features for Tools 9.1 up through Update 2 (9.1.2) and for Applications 9.1. This document does not apply to World. Note that most of the new UI features work with Applications 9.0, if you upgrade to Tools 9.1.

## Logon Screen

You'll notice the new look right away on the logon screen, as shown in Figure 1. If you are set up with multiple environments, you'll also be asked to select your environment, as shown in Figure 2.

## Home Page

Once you sign in, you'll see a modernized look for the Home Page, as shown in Figure 3a. The left Navigation options have been replaced by the Navigator at the top left of the screen to allow for increased screen size. Through Navigator, users can drill down through submenus to open their application, as shown in Figure 3b. Dropdown menus for Open Applications, Recent Reports, and Favorites are also available to the right of Navigator for quick access. The Application level is displayed prominently in the center of the page and the Tools release level is displayed at the bottom right. In the upper right menu you'll find Roles, Personalization options, and the current environment.
